#### KSDE TRANSITIONAL ASSESSMENTS

This year's 2013-2014 State assessments will be a transitional assessment aligned with the Kansas College and Career Ready Standards. These new math standards can be found by selecting the Kansas Math Standards. Below is a brief summary of the KSDE Transitional Assessment.

- The test will be multiple-choice with some technology enhanced items (i.e. multiple response and drag and drop).
- There will be no performance based items this year.
- The test will only have two parts.
- This assessment will only be available during the spring semester.
- The KAMM assessment will not be given this year.
- All students qualifying for alternate assessments will participate in the computerized Dynamic Learning Maps (DLM) field test in mathematics.
- There will not be opportunity to learn in place this year.
- The assessment will be delivered in a new online testing interface called KITE.
