ANNUAL SAFETY TRAINING INFORMATION

USD 443 Employees are required to complete annual safety training. Each employee will complete the training online at www.publicschoolworks.com/232.

Training will open September, 2013 and will close on the first week of November 2013. There are three (3) courses and each employee must successfully pass all three (3) courses to be considered complete. As each employee passes a course, it will not be possible to go back and take the test for a higher score. Only USD 443 employees are required to complete this training. 613 employees will complete training through 613.

To log on you will use your user name which will be your last name dot your first name (example: doe.jane). Your password is your ID# which you can find on your ID badge or on your paystub (example: 055526).
