
District Driven Goals Explicit Instruction

Learning Environment

- Effective Use of Teacher Proximity = $\underline{56\%}$
- Effective Classroom Management = <u>89%</u>
- Environment Reflects Respect & Rapport = 78%
- Physical Environment Supports Student Learning = 72%
- Teacher Asks and Answers Higher level Questions = 28%



Mastery Objective

- Is it posted? = 94%
- Is it communicated verbally? = $\underline{22\%}$
- Is it communicated throughout the lesson? = $\underline{6\%}$
- Does it match student activity? = 39%
- Does it include both components of the mastery objective? = 12%

Examples of Mastery Objective

- Students will demonstrate an understanding of adding fractions with unlike denominators by writing the steps involved in a "ticket out."
- The student will demonstrate they understand the characteristics of a dotted quarter note by correctly describing them to a partner.
