What is being compared?

What symbols are present?

• <u>Technology Skill Set:</u> (Search and highlight in blue all the words that provide symbolic representation.)

Why did the author choose these symbols?

• <u>Technology Skill Set:</u> (Select one portion of the text and send an e-mail to your advisory teacher explaining why the author chose these symbols.)
