Dear Parent,

Re: SIT Summer School Recommendation

The Dodge City Middle School Student Intervention Team (SIT) met on April 7, 2014 to review your child's academic progress for the 2013 – 2014 school year. Your child, in spite of having received the benefit of evidence-based Tier 1 and Tier 2 instruction and or interventions, has not shown the expected academic growth. Consultation between your child's core teachers and the school Student Intervention Team has resulted in your child being recommended for summer school.

The Student Intervention Team is composed of knowledgeable school staff that has worked collaboratively to deeply examine your child's strength and needs and has analyzed their response to previous interventions. The recommended four week summer enrichment program scheduled during the month of June will provide the additional time to explore more intensive and individualized intervention options.

Included with this summer notification letter is a Student Intervention Team recommendation form for you to sign. Additionally, we have included a summer school information brochure along with an enrollment and transportation forms. We are asking that you return the enrollment, transportation and SIT recommendation forms to school by April 25, 2014.
